SANDHILLS MOTORING FESTIVAL RECAP

The 2021 Sandhills Motoring Festival was a phenomenal success! After a harrowing 2020 filled with postponements and cancellations for any and all events, Memorial Day Weekend was a much needed and much welcomed time with thousands for auto enthusiasts flooding the streets of the historic Village of Pinehurst. We are pleased to announce that our goal of raising \$10,000 for the Sandhills Community College Automotive Technologies program doubled to a whopping \$20,450! This money will be used as an endowment to the College to provide financial assistance to students in the Automotive program with the goal of helping them achieve their educational dreams.

The weekend kicked off with a special Happy Hour by Hagerty that took place across the street from the SMF host hotel, the Pine Crest Inn. Dubbed the "Hagerty House" one of the primary SMF sponsors hosted a cocktail event for Hagerty Driver's Club members and SMF VIPs. Immediately following, the signature Automobiles and BBQ kicked off with excellent southern style BBQ, chicken, and sides. A live band provided the music, and Foreign Cars Italia provided the eye candy on display in the closed off street. While the dinner officially ended at 9pm, revelers were heard until the midnight hour talking about car culture and how wonderful it was to be back gathering at car events.

Saturday morning began with the SMF Road Rally, commissioned by yours truly. We launched over 40 cars for the rally which took drivers and their navigators over a 55-mile course throughout the Sandhills. Participants were provided with a list of questions to answer along their route, proving the need for keen observation skills, thinking caps, and a little bit of old-fashioned luck. The winners of the Road Rally were local couple (and soon to be MBCA members) Nick and Gillie in their 1982 Mercedes-Benz 300D. Upon completion of the Rally, entrants dined in the Pine Crest Inn for lunch to discuss how many questions they thought they answered correctly.

Saturday also featured a Pottery tour to Ben Owen Pottery, led by Past President, Steve Redwine. Participants traveled to Seagrove along the Pottery Highway and learned about the nuances and intricacies of pottery making.

Saturday evening wrapped up with the SMF Hangar Party at the Moore County Airport's main hangar. Featuring a low country boil for 200 guests, the hangar was stocked with exotic cars and airplanes. A storm off in the distance along with a welcome drop in temperature provided the perfect backdrop for this signature event.

Sunday's Concours in the Village got off to an early morning start as entrants were eager to find their parking spaces. A light mist shrouded the Village as the event began, and as I walked down the main street of Pinehurst with Steve Redwine, we turned around to see droves of spectators flocking to the beautiful display of automobiles. Over 130 cars lining the streets set against the lovely Pinehurst scenery, it was truly a sight to behold. As the skies cleared and the sun came out, you could feel the electricity and excitement in the air as entrants and spectators alike were smiling from ear to ear at the wide variety of autos. The crowd was full of awe and gasps as the winners across the Concours classes were announced.

The weekend wrapped up with the SMF Awards Dinner at the scenic Country Club of North Carolina that featured an Italian style buffet, a live auction MC'ed by Ramsey Potts which raised over \$5,000, and an evening filled with stories of the weekend. If those walls could talk!

The entire SMF team is very grateful for the support of MBCA and it's members, along with all of the sponsors, entrants, and guests of the weekend. We are already planning our improvements for SMF 2022!












SANDHILLS MOTORING FESTIVAL REVISITED




